



CCHA POINT SYSTEM

CCHA takes pride in the fact that their members pay a very minimal amount per year to enjoy and take part in our activities. In order to keep the costs down and participation in activities and events fair between members we have created a point system.

How the point system works:

Each member will be required to participate in certain meetings, horse shows, community service events, and activities to gain points towards convention and CCHA's end of the year event. Any member who gains 50 or more points throughout the year will go to convention and the end of the year event for minimal cost.

Point System Values and Calculations:

| Item | Point Value |
|------------------------------------|----------------------------|
| Meetings | 1 meeting = 3 points |
| Guest Speakers | 1 guest speaker = 3 points |
| Recreational Activities | 1 activity = 1 point |
| Trotting Round The Tree Horse Show | 1 hour = 1 point |
| JD Massey | 1 Shift = 3 Points |
| Community Service | 1 shift = 3 points |
| Other | Points Vary |

Each member will be required to have:

- 12 points for meetings (4 meetings)
- 6 points for guest speakers (2 guest speakers)
- 2 points for recreational activities (2 fun activities)
- 9 points for community service (3 community service events)
- 10 points for Trotting Round the Tree Horse Show (10 hours)
- 3 points for JD Massey Show/ or Extra community Service (1 shift)
- 8 points for other

50 Points Total

points will be subject to change depending on meetings, events, and activities put on by and made available to the organization. Valid excuses for not meeting the required points will be decided by the executive officers
